The Finale SC, as the name implies, is chartered to generate and organize the final aspects of the project and its report. DCR brings to the project its extensive staff experience in information protection, cyber security, healthcare interests and large project management.

The PHI Project is a new initiative on the financial impact of unauthorized access to protected health information (PHI). The PHI Project will culminate in a report targeted at those responsible for and entrusted with protecting and handling PHI. The purpose is to help inform the healthcare industry in making investment decisions to protect PHI, as well as improve responsiveness if and when this information is breached. The final project report will be presented at a news conference at the National Press Club in Washington DC and will subsequently be presented at a Congressional staff briefing on Capitol Hill. The PHI Project is a joint venture of the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) Identity Theft Prevention and Identity Management Standards Panel, The Shared Assessments Program and Healthcare Working Group, and the Internet Security Alliance.
